#### BATTERY SAFETY

The Willow Creek Regional Landfill accepts all types of batteries for recycling. This includes car and truck batteries, alkaline batteries, ni-cad and lithium ion batteries to name a few. It is important to know that batteries should not be landfilled as they pose certain environmental risks. Lithium ion batteries, for example, when handled improperly can cause landfill fires. Items that contain lithium ion batteries can include hearing aids, kitchen scales, singing greeting cards, wrist watches, cordless tools, laptops and cellular phones just to name a few. Please keep any of the above noted items out of your regular waste. We will accept them for recycling, FREE OF CHARGE, at the landfill during regular business hours.

Lithium ion button batteries in particular, must be handled properly even when they are assumed to be past their useful life. Button batteries should be individually taped with non-conductive tape before storing with other batteries. Once taped, it is best practice to use a plastic container to store them until they can be dropped off at the landfill for recycling.

We appreciate your diligence in helping us put waste in its proper place.

- Use of the landfill site may be denied to anyone who does not obey the directions of landfill staff.
- Landfill staff is permitted to inspect any load upon arrival at the landfill site. We maintain the right to refuse any unacceptable waste.
- Loose material including film plastic, paper, styrofoam etc. must be bagged, bundled or otherwise contained.
