SUPPLEMENTARY ASSESSMENT / TAX INFORMATION

What is a Supplementary Assessment?

Supplementary assessments reflect the increase in value of a property where a **new home** or **building / structure** is completed or occupied **during** the current tax year.

Supplementary assessment and tax provide for equity among **all** property owners. When new homes or buildings / structures are completed or occupied, the owners receive municipal services. Supplementary tax contributes towards the cost of providing these services.

The MD of Willow Creek No. 26 passed a "Supplementary Assessment" bylaw (Bylaw 1924) February 23, 2022 and a "Supplementary Tax" bylaw (Bylaw # 1937) this past October. Council must pass these bylaws annually.

How does Supplementary Assessment and Tax Work?

If your property is newly constructed, has had improvements or an addition, and was completed or occupied during the current tax year, you will receive a Supplementary Assessment and Tax Notice in addition to the annual tax notice that was mailed June 3, 2022.

The Supplementary Assessment and Tax Notice will reflect the **new** assessed value of the improvement. Taxes are then pro-rated from the date of completion or occupancy to the end of the year based on the **change** in improvement value.
